Introduction

Through your financial contributions, we were able to assist students who otherwise might not have been able to register for the Joint Admissions and Matriculation Board (JAMB) examination.

This report provides transparency regarding how the funds were utilized and outlines our plans for continued educational support for the students.

Students Sponsored

Through the contributions received, a total of: 34 students were successfully sponsored to register for the 2026 JAMB UTME examination.

This sponsorship helped remove financial barriers and provided these students with the opportunity to pursue admission into higher institutions.

Future Educational Support: Waec sponsorship Initiative

In order to continue supporting students academically, we are planning the next phase of the initiative. We intend to sponsor students for the WAEC GCE examination later in the year.

This project will be carried out in partnership with: Mummy Marho's Foundation for children, teenagers and youth.

Proposed WAEC Sponsorship Plan

Estimated cost per student ₦40,000

Target number of students 15

Total projected budget ₦600,000

The current balance from the JAMB sponsorship fund will serve as seed funding for this next phase, while we continue to seek additional partners and sponsors to fully fund the project.

Future Expansion: University Student Support Initiative

Following the success of the JAMB sponsorship program, we received a number of responses and applications from students who come from low-income and single-parent households and are currently struggling to continue their education at the university level due to financial constraints.

In response to this need, we are exploring the possibility of launching a University Student Support Fund that will provide financial assistance for tuition and essential academic expenses for deserving students in tertiary institutions.

This initiative will build on the impact of the Sponsor a Student program and will focus on supporting students who demonstrate academic commitment but lack the financial resources to sustain their education. We will continue to work with partners and sponsors to develop a transparent framework for identifying beneficiaries and providing meaningful support.

Closing Remarks

The success of the Sponsor a Student initiative demonstrates the powerful impact that collective generosity can have in transforming lives through education. Because of your support, 34 students were able to take an important step toward their academic future by registering for the 2026 JAMB examination.
